Town Hall Forum

To help educate viewers on physician-assisted suicide, which voters will consider as Question 2 this November, the CatholicTV Network hosted a town hall forum with Archbishop of Boston, **Cardinal Seán O'Malley**, a panel of experts and a live studio audience of concerned Catholics. The hour-long event moderated by ClearVoice™ host **John Monahan** featured the participants openly discussing physician-assisted suicide. The special will be rebroadcast through Election Day (Nov. 6). Cardinal Seán is encouraging Catholics to join him to stop assisted suicide by voting **"No on Question 2."**
